

First Baptist Church of Peoria Education Scholarships 2010-2011

Type of Assistance Offered

The First Baptist Church Scholarship program awards scholarships to qualifying applicants. These are not loans, but outright grants. Grants vary according to the applicant's financial needs, as well as to the number of applicants and amount of funds available each year. Repeat scholarships may be granted to applicants, with the understanding that priority will be given to first time applicants.

How to Apply for a Scholarship

1. Complete the application form attached.
2. Send the Scholarship Committee your most recent school transcript, including grade point average and class standing.

Application Deadline is April 30, 2010

After decisions are made by the Scholarship Committee recipients and non-recipients will be notified in June. Half of the yearly amount will be sent in August and the remaining balance in December.

Scholarship Qualifications

1. An active member or participant in the life of First Baptist Church of Peoria.
2. Seeking to advance one's education beyond the high school level.
3. In need of financial assistance.
