

HOW CAN THE PARISH NURSE HELP YOU?

- Check your blood pressure and general health status
- Refer you to appropriate medical provider
- Visit you in the hospital or nursing home
- Visit you in your home to assess your needs, to listen, to support, to pray
- Assist you to understand and organize your medications
- Help you with your concerns of children, other family members, aging parents
- Help you better understand your own health care needs
- Refer you to the ministers for specific spiritual needs

WHAT THE PARISH NURSE WILL NOT DO

- Replace the ministers.
- Replace your regular healthcare professional or home health provider.
- Perform hands-on care such as bathing, dressing changes, injections.
